

PRESS RELEASE

The Winter Session, 2010 of Parliament (6th Session of Fifteenth Lok Sabha and the 221st Session of the Rajya Sabha) is scheduled to commence on Tuesday, the 9th of November, 2010 and subject to exigencies of Government Business, the Session will conclude on Monday, the 13th of December, 2010. The Session will provide 24 sittings spread over a period of 35 days.

2. The Session will mainly be devoted to essential Government legislative and other business, including financial business relating to Supplementary Demand for Grants for the year 2010-11 in respect of General Budget.

3. To finalise the Government Business for the Winter Session, 2010, Minister of Parliamentary Affairs took a meeting with the Secretaries/Senior Officers of the various Ministries/Departments on Wednesday, the 3rd of November, 2010. The Minister of State in the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs co-chaired the meeting.
